

# 2009 Gingerbread Charity Competition



The Bio Sheet must be returned by November 27, 2009 to reserve space.

**Set up is on Tuesday, December 1, 2009, 3:30pm -4:45pm  
At the McFaddin-Ward House Visitor Center, 1906 Calder Avenue at Third Street**

All competition entries must be made of 100% edible food items except the base board of the display (recommended ¾" Plywood for the base Board) and candy wrappers. Wrappers may be left on the candy. Non-edible support structure material may not be used except the baseboard. Showpiece designs must be original.

All entries in any category must be on a base board no larger than 20"x 20" and the overall display absolutely no taller than 24 inches. A competitor can create and position many building or objects as they wish on the 20"x 20" board (or smaller).

A 3x5 card (with house name and brief statement about the house inspiration) to accompany showpiece.
